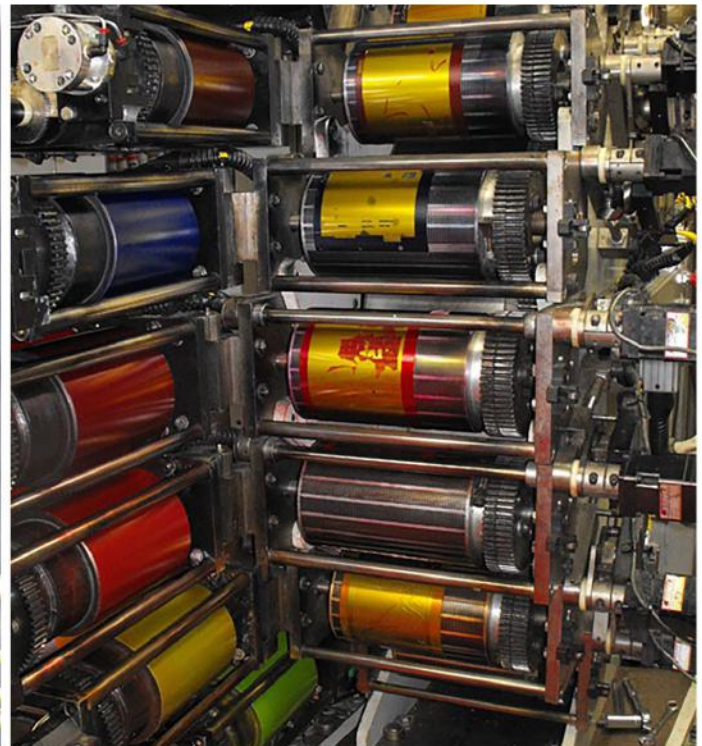


## INTRODUCTION TO DRY OFFSET PRINTING

- Measuring dot gain and ink density with a densitometer  
/ Balancing color on press
- Setting a colorhead for optimum results
- Troubleshooting: Inks, Blankets, Plates, Rollers
- Understanding the Ink Fountain and Colorhead

This course is comprised of classroom as well as on-press instruction. Each trainee will have the opportunity to balance roller pressures and ink flow during the press labs.
